

# EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGY GRADUATE CERTIFICATES

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Oklahoma. The required 5 courses are: EDPC 5513, EDSP 5413, EDPC 5113, EDPC 5253, and EACS 5233.

## Graduate Certificate in Applications of Educational Research and Evaluation

The Applications of Educational Research and Evaluation Graduate Certificate provides a strong foundation in the techniques for conducting program evaluations using educational research, and offers a series of high quality online courses. A total of 12 hours is required for the certificate, EIPT 5033, EIPT 5023, EIPT 5203, and EIPT 6073.

## Graduate Certificate in Applied Behavior Analysis

The Applied Behavior Analysis Graduate Certificate provides students with a comprehensive set of skills that integrates theory and ethical practices of applied behavior analysis. A total of 18 hours is required for the certificate, EDSP 5143, EDSP 5243, EDSP 5343, EDSP 5443, EDSP 6023 and 3 elective hours from EDSP 5063 or EDSP 5013.

## Graduate Certificate in Drug and Alcohol Counseling

The embedded certificate in Drug & Alcohol Counseling requires 15 hours which are specific to drug and alcohol counseling that meet or exceed all requirements for licensure in the state of Oklahoma. This is not a standalone certificate- it provides a transcribed credential for students who wish to pursue licensure as drug and alcohol counselors in the state of Oklahoma. The required courses are: EDPC 5513, EDPC 5523, EDPC 5533, EDPC 5543, and EDPC 5553.

## Graduate Certificate in Fundamentals of Special Education

The curriculum for this embedded certificate consists of six (6) graduate courses that are the most necessary and fundamental courses for persons who are interested in teaching individuals with disabilities, but have not received their undergraduate degree or master's degree in Special Education. The required 18 hours of courses are: EDSP 5413, EDSP 5143, EDSP 5183, EDSP 5163, EDSP 5013, and a 3 hour elective course in special education (or general education) that pertains to the student's primary professional area of interest.

## Graduate Certificate in Secondary Transition Education Specialist

The Secondary Transition Education Specialist Graduate Certificate provides students with a comprehensive set of skills that integrates the theory and practice of transition education. A total of 12 hours is required for the certificate, EDSP 5093, EDSP 5193, EDSP 5293, and S WK 5293,

## Graduate Certificate in School Counseling

The curriculum for this embedded certificate includes a sequence of five (5) graduate courses that are part of the concentration in School Counseling within the Master's program in Professional Counseling. The certificate provides a transcribed credential for students who wish to pursue alternative certification as school counselors in the state of
