The Taxation Graduate Certificate will provide students with advanced and focused knowledge in business and personal taxation, preparing them for positions as tax advisors in professional service firms, tax and finance departments of businesses, and federal and state departments of revenue (e.g., the iRS, the Oklahoma Department of Revenue).

- No course substitutions are permitted for graduate certificates.
- Coursework applied to a graduate certificate cannot be more than five years old as of the semester the graduate certificate is awarded.
- Students must earn a grade point average of 3.00 or higher on all coursework applied to the graduate certificate.
